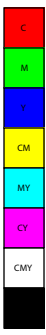
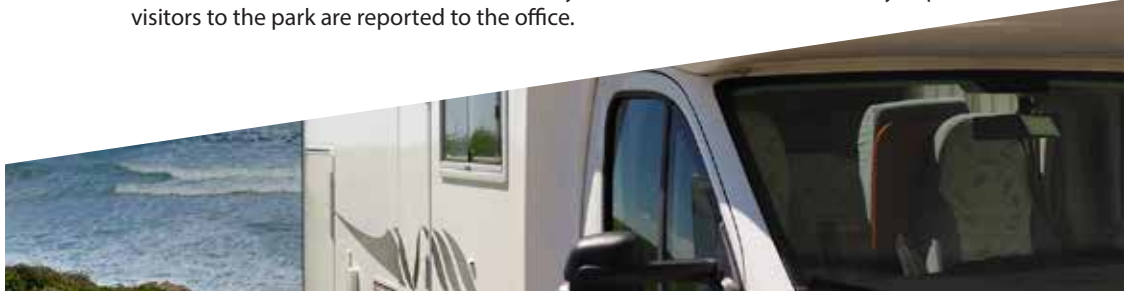


We need your help

Sligo Tourist Development Association are delighted to welcome you on site and hope you have a really pleasant stay. While we have put significant planning into the safe reopening of our parks we will depend on Your help in doing all possible to ensure an enjoyable and safe experience. Striking the balance between enjoying a good holiday experience and helping us to keep you and our staff safe will mean some significant changes to the normal way we do business but we are confident the steps in place will ensure good compliance. No doubt there will be things that happen that haven't been foreseen but with co operation we will sort things as we go.

Following the recently published guidelines from Failte Ireland, giving details of the rules surrounding the implementation of the required Covid 19 restrictions, we have made changes to the facilities on site and these will be under constant review as the season goes on. Measures to include,

- Implementation of a minimum 7 night stay for caravans and motor homes, with a minimum stay of 4 nights for tents in order to cut down on the turnover of units.
- Closure of the games room, sitting room area and the playground .
"On-site toilet and shower blocks will be available for use but due to the strict protocols around cleaning and in order to maintain physical distancing some restrictions will apply.
- Customers should be aware that delays may occur at busy times (morning and evening). **For these reasons, caravan and motor home users are asked where possible to use their on board sanitary facilities".** It is really important that baby wipes are not disposed of in toilets and chemical loos as they are not biodegradable and **BLOCK THE SEWER.**
- Other facilities such as laundry, campers kitchen and pot wash will be open for use, but with the necessary social distancing restrictions in place. For the safety of our customers and staff, hand sanitisers and information signage will be placed around the park.
- As we will be operating physical distancing in our reception area, **on arrival one representative from each group or family should go to check in** while the others adhere to physical distancing measures. Further information on security, access and Covid 19 measures will issue at check in.
- Remember please use the hand sanitizers and respect social distancing. Please also leave toilets and sinks clean after use.
- In order to comply with HSE requirements regarding contact tracing, we will keep records of each unit that check in on site and when they leave. For this reason it is really important that visitors to the park are reported to the office.
